

Dear Friends,

Dear Supporters:

Our 2023 year was a Pivot (any Friends fans here? Did you just hear that in Ross's voice?).

I joined our team in April 2023, after more than 20 years in the insurance industry. This is my first nonprofit role and was a career pivot I chose and accepted gratefully as I continued to heal from a personal pivot I didn't choose – the accidental death of my husband of 23+ years in July 2021.

Early in my grief, I chose the phrase "Stubborn Hope" to carry me through each day, each hour, sometimes each minute. I know that God is a God of hope, faith, and love. He promises to be with us and never leave us. Back in December 2022, my pastor said in his sermon: "Jesus doesn't just want to write Himself into your story, He wants to write a better story with your life." Even in the darkest season of life, the Lord is present and is the same, yesterday, today, and forever.

Our organization pivoted in 2023 as well. With the challenging U.S. economy, as well as misinformation that the 2022 Dobbs decision solved the abortion situation, our incoming financial support in 2023 decreased significantly compared to 2022. Rather than operating out of fear and reacting to financial needs from a mindset of lack, our team pivoted.

With a lower monthly operating budget, we became more intentional about tracking financial requests, client involvement in financial coaching, and finding alternatives to resolve their needs.

Going into 2024, we will continue to love and serve our clients with a mindset and heart posture of abundance. We have not turned away any legitimate client need due to our budget shortfall, and we praise God for continuing to provide our needs. He is a God of abundance. As Luke 6:38 says (NASB): "Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, and running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return."

As we reflect on 2023, we are grateful for many things:

- · A dedicated, Christ-centered staff and volunteer team
- Clients that reach out and allow us to walk with them for a season
- Babies that are born, each one a miracle
- People that pray for us regularly, for we know that we struggle not against flesh and blood
- The Lord is with us, we seek His face, and He shows us each step to take

We serve in Love. We have Stubborn Hope. We know we are the children and heirs of the Most High God. May this encourage you today and thank you for the ways you support this Kingdom work. We cannot do what we do without you.

In 2023, you have helped us serve over 1,600 LoveLine clients! We continue to see an average of 150 contacts per month. Our hotline team responds and screens contacts over the phone, filtering them through our intake manager if a local resource cannot be provided directly. We are grateful to have moved over to better technology in 2023 that allows our remote team to handle the texts to LoveLine and the screening process more effectively and efficiently at a very little cost difference from before!

Once the intake appointment is completed, the client will be assigned a case manager to walk them one- on-one through her unique situation with an individualized case plan. These are our disbursements, services provided, and positive outcomes in 2023!

Eliana was already struggling. Upon discovering her pregnancy, she considered abortion and inquired about the procedure at a pregnancy center. The center confirmed the pregnancy, performed an ultrasound, and Eliana waited for the designated time before she could schedule an abortion per her state's mandatory waiting requirement. However, she contacted LoveLine and poured out all of the reasons that made her afraid to have another baby. Despite her despair and fear, Eliana courageously gave LoveLine a chance to walk alongside her. She came to strongly believe that if she kept the baby, the Lord would provide every step of the way.

LoveLine helped Eliana advocate for affordable housing to stabilize herself and her daughter. Eliana also enrolled in LoveLine's financial coaching program and worked with all her coach's recommendations. She followed through with her case plan and worked hard to get out of crisis and into stability. Eliana enrolled in school so she could improve her career prospects. With LoveLine's assistance, Eliana smoothly transitioned to managing her own budget on a weekly basis. Additionally, she also utilized LoveLine's counseling services and found a support system through church and Bible study.



Eliana's beautiful baby girl was born in November 2023. She worked through the natural adjustments of the first couple of months with a two-year-old and a newborn, successfully managing her finances. Today, Eliana feels like she is in a good place with her mental health. Shortly after graduating from LoveLine's financial coaching program, Eliana and her case manager agreed that she had met her case plan goals. Eliana has the skills and determination to continue the path towards stability and independence that she has created for her and her girls. Eliana said,

We launched All My Options in 2023, in collaboration with Sidewalk Advocates for Life and our sister organization, And Then There Were None: https://allmyoptions.com.

This is a landing page for anyone near or entering an abortion facility, accessed through QR codes held as signs or handed out on cards outside the facilities. Clinic patients, human-trafficking survivors, abortion workers, and people passing by are redirected to life-affirming national outreach services from the website.


